
The history of paper


Paper is a writing material that was first invented in ancient China




The first papermaking process was documented in period 25-220 AD

The oldest way of making paper in China.





The first found papers



The word "paper" is etymologically derived from *papyrus*, Ancient Greek for the <u>Cyperus papyrus</u> plant.



Papyrus is older than paper

PAPYRUS is a thick, paper-like material produced from the pith of the *Cyperus papyrus* plant which was used in ancient Egypt and other Mediterranean cultures for writing long before the making of paper in China






at home, at school, in business, when travelling, all kind of jobs, offices, in art and science too
















How is paper made today

Paper is simple material. It is essentially a mat held together by the fiber's roughness, and can be made from almost any fibrous material like wood or recycled paper.



Here are 5 steps - how paper is produced

STEP 1: FORESTRY – Trees are cut down for making paper

STEP 2: DEBARKING/ CHIPPING – wood is cut into small pieces and mixed with water and chemicals

STEP 3: PULP PREPARATION – pulp is washed, refined, cleaned and sometimes coloured

STEP 4: PAPER FORMATION – Paper is squeezed between two rollers and it is dried into thin sheet

STEP 5: PAPER FINISHING – Paper is cut into smaller pieces and it is ready for use

Paper is made in factories – Paper mills

1. Try to not use so much paper

2. If you are drawing – try to use both sides



3. Throw paper into special dustbins designed for paper waste

4. Collect paper and take it to recycling centre

5 Paper Tips: Think Before You Print

 Go digital – read, send and store digital documents

3. Be selective about what you print

 Reach for the right paper

5. Recycle
